The Bed Receptacle Single 37-Pin connector is a 37-Pin connector that acts as an interface between compatible GE Healthcare patient-staff communications systems and Hill-Rom® or Stryker® electronic beds. It is specifically used to enable siderail communications with the patient-staff communications system.

The HC-BID-SS37 is compatible with Telligence™, ProCare 6000®, and ProCare 2000® patient-staff communication systems. It is mounted to a standard single gang plaster ring mounted on a 4 in (10.2 cm) backbox adjacent to the patient bed. Connections are made with standard termination tools.
